About the Youth Gambling Awareness Program:

- Recent Ontario Studies show that gambling patterns begin as early as 8 years of age and can be established before an adolescent reaches high school.
- Studies also show that 70% to 90% of youth are involved in gambling behaviours and of that percentage, as many as 15% are showing signs of problem gambling.
- We are a prevention/awareness program designed to reduce the harm associated with youth gambling.
- We are funded by the Ontario Ministry of Health Promotion.

Our Approach:

- We are gambling neutral.
- We empower youth to make informed and healthy decisions about gambling. Topics such as: luck, decision making, skill vs. chance and odds/ randomness are covered.



What we offer:

- Presentations for **day camps** in the Guelph, Kitchener-Waterloo, Cambridge area, as well as **residential camps** associated. Presentations are 30—60 minutes in length.
- **Indoor / Outdoor** interactive, age-appropriate presentations with games and props.
- Special presentations geared towards staff or leaders-in-training (LIT).
- Referrals for gambling treatment services, if needed.
- Available on weekends and evenings.
